

Scholarship Application Process Academic Year 2022-2023

The Application Review Process

The St. Paul Scholarship Ministry conducts the actual review of the application and supporting documentation. Attention is given to every aspect of the application. Church auxiliary participation, volunteer service hours, as well as the Personal Statement of Purpose, are all taken into consideration in the review process. The applicant must be a senior graduating from High School.

Required Documentation

Please include the following with the application: a copy of final high school transcript (transcript must indicate passing of FSA or alternative test); Copy of official SAT and/or ACT Test Scores; Copy of admission letter from a college, university or technical school.

Application Deadlines

In order to be considered for a 2023 award, a completed application and supporting documentation must be submitted no later than *May 19,2023* for fall 2023, winter 2023 and spring 2024 enrollment.

Scholarship Awards

Scholarship award amounts will be determined based on the criteria listed on the attached pages. Scholarship is made payable to the student. Scholarship recipients will be notified after the application review process.

Scholarship with be disbursed upon confirmation of enrollment at a college, university or technical school.

Scholarship Criteria Academic Year 2022-2023

1. To receive the \$500.00 scholarship a student must:

- a) Have a 3.0 GPA or higher
- b) Score at least an 1200 on the SAT (verbal and math scores total) or 20 on the ACT
- c) Proof of Acceptance to a college, university or technical school
- d) Active member of St. Paul Baptist Church (Church, Sunday School, Ministries, etc.)
- e) Pass the FSA or alternative

2. To receive the \$400.00 scholarship a student must:

- a) Have at least a 3.0 GPA **or** Score at least an 1200 on the SAT (verbal and math scores total) or 20 on the ACT
- b) Proof of Acceptance to a college, university or technical school
- c) Active member of St. Paul Baptist Church (Church, Sunday School, Ministries, etc.)
- d) Pass the FSA or alternative

3. To receive the \$300.00 scholarship a student must:

- a) Have at least 2.7 GPA **or** Score at least an 900 on the SAT (verbal and math scores total) or 18 on the ACT
- b) Proof of Acceptance to a college, university or technical school
- c) Active member of St. Paul Baptist Church (Church, Sunday School, Ministries, etc.)
- d) Pass the FSA or alternative

4. To receive the \$200.00 scholarship a student must:

- a) Have at least a 2.5 GPA **or** Score at least an 800 on the SAT (verbal and math scores total) or 16 on the ACT
- b) Proof of Acceptance to a college, university or technical school
- c) Active member of St. Paul Baptist Church (Church, Sunday School, Ministries, etc.)
- d) Pass the FSA or alternative

5. To receive the \$100.00 scholarship a student must:

- a) Have at least a 2.0 GPA
- b) Proof of Acceptance to a college, university or technical School
- c) Active member of St. Paul Baptist Church (Church, Sunday School, Ministries, etc.)
- d) Pass the FSA or alternative

Scholarship Ministry's Gift Criteria Academic Year 2022-2023

- 1. To receive a \$50.00 gift, a high student must:
 - a) Be a member of St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church
 - b) Receive a high school diploma or its equivalent
- 2. To receive a monetary gift, a college student must:
 - a) Be a member of St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church
 - b) Be enrolled in an undergraduate, graduate or technical program at a college, university or technical school.
